



Swamp Rose

Rosa palustris

An attractive shrub throughout the year with red fruits that are eaten by wildlife. It grows best in damp or wet rich loamy soil, in full sun or partial shade. This species rose is generally not susceptible to the disease and insect pests that attack many hybrid roses.

Soil Tolerance: Average, Clay, Sandy, Moist, Poorly drained
