











Hollow Joe-pye Weed

Eutrochium fistulosum

A favorite of pollinators with huge, domed flower heads, Hollow Joepye Weed is a dramatic back-of-the-border garden plant. Found near freshwater pond edges, it prefers partial shade, and moist soil.
