





Beach Pea Lathyrus maritima

Beach pea is a low, prostrate plant which can spread by underground roots (rhizomes). An easily grown plant, it prefers full sun. As a member of the Pea Family, it fixes atmospheric nitrogen. Fruit is a smooth flat pod, $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 3 inches long and nearly $\frac{1}{2}$ inch wide. No serious insect or disease problems.
