



Bearberry Arctostaphylos uva-ursi

A trailing, evergreen shrub, the thick, leathery leaves are yellowgreen in spring, dark-green in summer, and reddish-purple in the fall. Nodding clusters of pink or white flowers occur on bright-red stems, followed by bright-red berries that persist into winter. Long lived, but a slow grower. Has no serious disease or insect problems. Frequently seen as a ground cover in sandy areas.
