



Panickedleaf ticktrefoil

Desmodium paniculatum

This legume grows low and is a pioneer species in disturbed areas. Like most legumes, it enriches the soil through nitrogen fixation. Showy, small flowers are pink/purple and mature from the bottom up-wards. After flowering, the leguminous seed pods approximately $\frac{1}{8}$ inch long and can stick to fur of animals can end up in new locations.
